

*** *** Research expenditure by sector




2019; internal expenditure on R&D by sector



Higher education institutions

- 420 universities and other higher education institutions
- 156 entitled to confer doctorates
- more than 43,000 international doctoral students
- around 55,000 international academics
- Excellence Strategy: €533m per year for top-class research



Intensive innovation







Individual PhD vs. structured PhD

Individual

- individual research accompanied by supervisor
- supervisor must be found by doctoral student
- subject chosen by doctoral student
- optional courses or other forms of teaching/learning

Structured

- guidance by a team of supervisors
- dissertation subject must fit in with research programme
- mandatory, fixed supporting curriculum (interdisciplinary)
- defined application process
- offered by research training groups/graduate schools



- no tuition fees, only administrative persemester charges
- average living costs:
 approx. €867 (\$975) per month
- funding opportunities:
 - scholarship
 - paid PhD position
 - research associate contracts (part-time)
 - research job in a company
 - part-time job (as waiter/waitress or other casual work)





Funding for PhD students

Graduate and research schools

- DFG-funded Research Training Groups (research programmes with a thematic focus)
- Graduate School Scholarship Programme (GSSP): DAAD-funded programmes at universities or non-university research institutions
- International Max Planck Research Schools (IMPRS)
- Helmholtz International Research Schools and Helmholtz Graduate Schools
- Max Planck Schools (joint initiative of German universities and non-university research institutions)
- structured programmes offered by universities and other higher education institutions





Funding for PhD students

Individual funding

- individual doctoral projects at universities
- individual doctoral projects at nonuniversity research institutes:
 - Fraunhofer Institutes
 - Leibniz Institutes
 - Max Planck Institutes
- DLR-DAAD Research Fellowships

** ** DAAD-scholarships for Chinese researchers

CAS-DAAD joint scholarship program (duration: 12-22 months)

Chinese researchers get the chance to carry out part of their PhD in Germany

Value: EUR 1.350,- (1st year) EUR 1.200,- (2nd year)

- +additional allowances
- Sino-German (CSC-DAAD) Postdoc Scholarship Program (duration: 6-24 months)

Value: EUR 2.050 +additional allowances

DAAD Research Grant (Duration: max. 48 months)

Value: EUR 1.200 + Travel allowance +insurances+ annual research allowance + German language course




